

REPORT ON WORLD HOMOEOPATHY DAY CELEBRATED ON 10TH APRIL 2016

The North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy, Shillong celebrated “World Homoeopathy Day “ which coincided with 261st Birth Anniversaries of Dr. Samuel Hahnemann the founder of Homoeopathy systems of medicine. The celebration was held on 10th April 2016 at Library Block of NEIAH campus Mawdiangdiang. The theme of the day was “Homoeopathy as a System of Medicine”.

The programme which started at 10:00 AM continued till 4:00 PM. The programme commenced with the arrival of Guests and Invitees. The Chief Guest for the occasion was Shri .P.S. Dkhar, IAS, Deputy Commissioner of East Khasi Hill Hills. On his arrival the programme was initiated by the welcoming and felicitation of the dignitaries by presenting them bouquets and Mementos. The programme was inaugurated by “Lighting of Lamp” by dignitaries followed by offering floral tributes to Dr. S. Hahnemann. A colourful inaugural cultural dance “Shad Mastieh” was presented by the artists of Snap Paka Institute Shillong. The dance which entertained the audience was appreciated by all.

The welcome address was delivered by Director, NEIAH, Prof. (Dr.) P.K. Goswami who extended a warm welcome to Chief Guest, other Guests and Invitees. He thanked everyone present for sparing their valuable time to attend the celebration. In his address he highlighted the objectives and status of the institute besides future of homoeopathy and other systems of health care under AYUSH.

Dr. W.Y.Hu Dhar (Rtd), AYUSH in-charge of Meghalaya State and Dr.S.I Kharshandi, MO Govt. of Meghalaya Shillong delivered their speeches expressed their views focusing on the theme of Homoeopathy as a system of medicine in general and its applicability and benefits to the NE region. Dr. Dhar said that the basic concept and the sciences of Homoeopathy is a precious gift to the humanity and has tremendous potential to provide health care easily affordable by citizens. They thank Ministry of AYUSH for establishing an institute of large magnitude like NEIAH in the North East Region which will surely contribute to the healthcare of the entire North East Region.

Sh. P.S. Dkhar, IAS, Deputy Commissioner East Khasi Hill Shillong in his address expressed his pleasure in getting an opportunity to attend this function. He expressed thanks to Government of India for establishing this institute in NER and locating it at Shillong which will contribute to health care of the population of NER in general and Meghalaya in particular. Having earlier worked in the AYUSH branches of Meghalaya Government he highlighted the steps taken by Government of Meghalaya to popularize and strengthen the Homoeopathy systems of health care. A light refreshment was served to all those presence before starting the technical session. The first lecture was delivered by Dr. H. Lato , Civil Hospital Nongstoin who deliberated upon the subject of “ Homoeopathy as system of Medicine” This lectures was attended by persons from other stream of medical professions as well as other professions . The objective of the lecture was to familiarize non professionals about homoeopathy and also to bring out essential strength of Homoeopathy for the professionals.

The second lecture titled homoeopathy in the Health care management was delivered by Dr. B. Barman, Reader and HOD of SJN Homoeopathy College and Hospital Guwahati. During his lecture he highlighted the various schemes launched by Govt. of India under Homoeopathy system of Health care particularly for Women and Children.

The lectures were educative and beneficial to the listeners.

In the post lunch session there was an interaction held among the professionals with Director, NEIAH and Dr. B. Barman as panelists. The theme of the discussion was mainly on AYUSH systems of Medicine with stress on means to improve knowledge of students, improved research and development activities, documentation and contribution to health care of the general masses. Also about steps that could be taken to popularize the AYUSH systems and to reach out to the remotest places of the country for providing services.

The interactive session and discussions were thought provoking and highly educative.

In the end a vote of thanks was delivered by Sh. Tapan Chakraborty , Administrative Officer, NEIAH on behalf of Director, Organizing committee and all staff members of NEIAH to all the Dignitaries, Guest lecturers ,Guests media persons , and all participants .
