Sir/Madam,

North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy, Mawdiangdiang Shillong- 793018 has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 63 seats in BHMS course and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of total 08 seats in 04 subjects namely 02 seats Organon of Medicine, 02 seats in Repertory, 02 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 02 seats in Practice of Medicine for academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARBH) has conducted Inspection on 22.05.2025 and 23.05.2025. MARBH has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards 2024 as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

1. Teaching Faculty:

• In UG

There are few teachers deficient in the college.

• In PG

College has deficiency of few teachers in PG Department of the college.

2. Hospital functionality:

There is deficiency of few staff in the hospital.

3. Miscellaneous:

- i. In METU books and journals on medical education technology and stationary are not available.

An Affidavit of Declaration is submitted by the Director-in-charge of North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy, Shillong. Considering the assurance provided in the affidavit by the Authorized Signatory and Competent Authority, where it has been mentioned that the shortage of faculty at NEIAH, Shillong will be filled up in this current Financial Year. MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional permission** to North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy, Mawdiangdiang Shillong- 793018 for continuing UG (BHMS) course with Intake Capacity of 63 (including EWS) seats and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of


total 08 seats in 04 subjects namely 02 seats Organon of Medicine, 02 seats in Repertory, 02 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 02 seats in Practice of Medicine for academic year 2025-26 – reg.

The institute will rectify all the deficiencies mentioned in point no 1, 2 and 3 of the letter before admission to UG and PG M.D. (Hom.) course and compliance shall be submitted to MARBH, failing which permission may be withdrawn.

4. It is further to mention that all admissions shall be made from NEET/ AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that 50% of undergraduate seats and 50% of postgraduate seats of the total permitted intake capacity of 63 UG seats and 8 PG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. The Counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by the designated authority of the Central Government. The remaining UG seats and PG seats (except foreign quota seat, if applicable) shall be treated as State Quota seats for Northeastern States. The counselling for State Quota seats shall be conducted by the designated counselling authority of the State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
5. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

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
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
