REPORT ON 'WORLD HOMOEOPATHY DAY 2017'

North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy (NEIAH), an autonomous institute under Ministry of AYUSH, Mawdiangdiang, Shillong celebrated "World Homoeopathy Day" on 10th April, 2017along with Oration Programme, to mark the 262nd Birth Anniversary of Dr. Samuel Hahnemann (Founder of Homoeopathy) in the Institute Campus under the theme "Enhancing the quality of Research in Homoeopathy".

In this function, Prof. R. Sharma, Dean, School of Life Sciences, NEHU, Shillong graced the occasion as the Chief Guest in lighting the lamp in the presence of Prof. (Dr.) P.K.Goswami, Director, NEIAH; Prof. (Dr.) P.
